"My bride, Katie, wanted a glamorous but subtle Indian style make-up look for her themed wedding, but it's also ideal for an edgy bride who isn't going for the traditional white or ivory dress."

Lara says: "Katie's look was created using Giorgio Armani Luminous Silk Foundation followed by MAC's Prep and Prime Transparent Finishing Powder to create a flawless skin and Estée Lauder Double Wear Stay-in-Place Flawless Wear Concealer to hide any under eye darkness.

For the eyebrows I used Beautiful Brows in light brown. I then opted for a smoky eye with golden tones complementing the bride's beautiful accessories. To achieve this I blended Painterly, Cork, Woodwinked, Tempting, and Dazzlelight, all by MAC. Next I applied Bobbi Brown Long-Wear Eyeliner in Chocolate Shimmer and finished with YSL Volume Effect Water-Resistant Mascara.

NARS Blusher in Orgasm was used on her cheeks, followed by Charlotte Tilbury's Filmstar Bronze & Glow to add contour and highlight.

Finally, I wanted the main focus to be on the lips to accentuate her red bindi and match her stunning red dress, so to bring the look to life and create this overall focus, I selected MAC lipstick in Cockney."

Jo says: "The bride's hair was curled using a conical wand. I created height on the crown area and the sides were twisted round to join. To finish, the beautiful headpiece was added and clipped in place."

Laetitia says: "I began with a rich, iridescent honey colour across the eyelid, a pink-brown in the socket line and a deep red-brown in the outer corner, swept upwards and outwards.

A waterproof deep brown eyeliner was applied along the upper lash line and semi-permanent lashes really helped to elongate the eye shape and add definition. Brows were darkened to balance this bolder eye. Cheeks were contoured with bronzer, highlighted and a rose tone added to the apples for a healthy pop of colour. A pink-plum on the lips that reflected the plum flowers from the bouquet completed the look."
